- a) *Matching technical requirements with Smart Systems technologies for the smart hospital of the future (90 minutes)*

This session aims at providing sets of smart technologies required to realise the functionalities driving the different sub-areas selected as well as identifying sweet / white spots for which actions should be defined.

- b) *Brainstorming for the emergence of joint projects (60 minutes)*

This brainstorming targets both specific calls (for instance H2020 DT-ICT-12-2020: The Smart Hospital of the Future) as well as projects without pre-defined scopes or content and is moderated by regional clusters involved in the inSSlight project: MINALOGIC, microTEC Südwest and MESAP.
